Dear Artists and Art Supporters -

Get ready for something new in June! Art and Ag is pleased to offer artists four different sunflower farms to choose from - ALL within convenient proximity to each other - and ALL with unique points of view. Art and Ag partner, Frank Muller, was kind enough to ask his neighbors to participate in what we are calling a Sunflower Spectacular!

Participating farms are: Aoki and Sons, Barrios Farms, Muller Ranch and Ochoa Farms. Artists will have the option to visit any of these farms during the four hour period on Thursday and Saturday.

You can explore these properties which are within an 8 mile radius until you find the location that speaks to you. For example, at Muller Ranch, artists can drive up on the bank of the slough to get an "aerial" view of their sunflower fields; or you might prefer to view sunflowers growing in front of the barn at another location.



Here's how it works:
Everyone starts out at Muller Ranch. There you will be given a map to the participating farms. Look for signs at each farm entrance. You can spend as much time at each venue until noon. On Saturday only, artists are invited to return to

Muller Ranch at noon for sharing of artwork and light refreshments.

According to Frank this is the biggest year for sunflowers ever in Yolo county. Over 50,000 acres of sunflowers have been planted, nearly double from last year. Why so many sunflowers? This season there is great worldwide demand for sunflower planting-seeds, making it a highly profitable commodity to grow. "It's the best place in the world to grow sunflowers" says Frank, whose farm was one of the first along with Circle G Ranch to grow them back in 1976. "Everyone thought we were crazy, but it turned out to be one of the best decisions we ever made."


