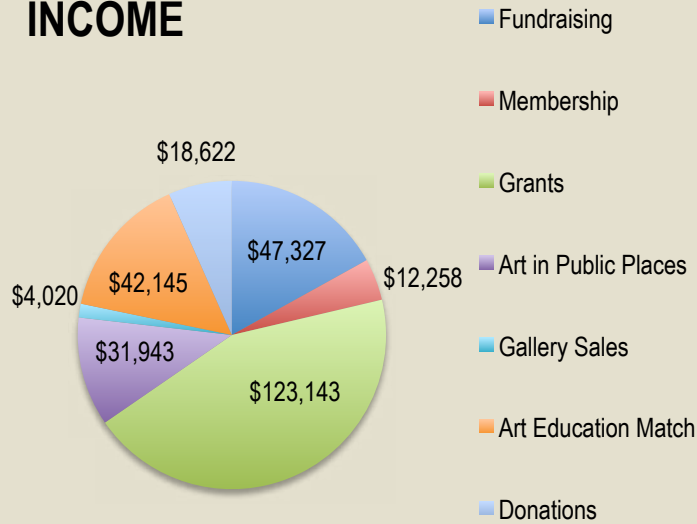
# YoloArts Mission Statement

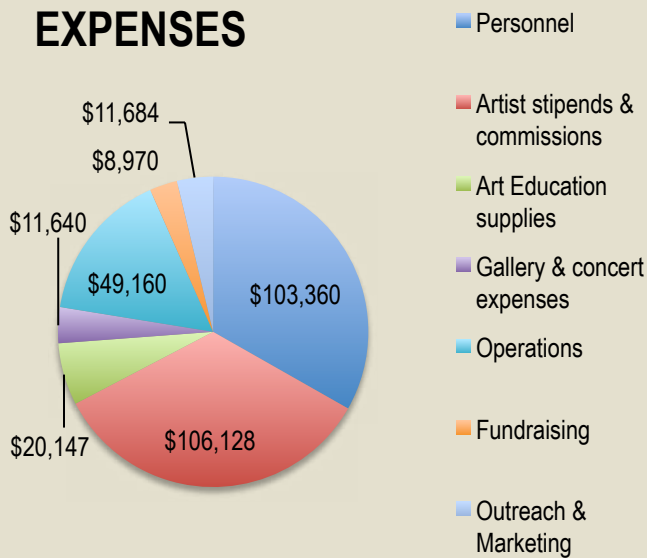
### 2013-14 Finance Highlights
