YoloArts curates rotating exhibitions at this public gallery in partnership with the County of Yolo. Gallery 625 is located at 625 Court Street, Woodland on the first floor of the County Administration Building. The gallery provides exhibitions and hosts First Friday opening receptions showcasing a diverse range of visual and performing arts. Our vision is to increase awareness and access to the arts in Yolo County and contribute to the emergent fine arts culture and economy of our region.

Artwork Guidelines

Artists submitting artwork for consideration will assure the following:

- The artwork is solely the result of the artistic effort of the artist
- Artwork has not been previously exhibited at Gallery 625
- Original artwork that compliments the exhibition space - 2D work (no smaller than 6"x 8" framed and no larger than 48"x48") 3D work to fit into glass cases 5'W x 4'H x 1.5'D
- Artwork must meet professional gallery display standards and be framed and **wired** to be installation-ready. Paintings on canvas do not need to be framed.

Application Guidelines to exhibit at Gallery 625

- Fill out online application form: <https://yoloarts.org/hidden-talents-yolo-county-employee-show/> which includes the option to upload up to 3 (three) JPEG or PNG image(s) that best represent your work. 500kb- 2MB
- Also include:
 - description of artwork including: Title, media, dimensions
 - a short paragraph describing your process, the inspiration for your artwork
 - your job title and number of years you have worked for the county
- Optional: Upload any additional images onto your YoloArts Artist Directory page or include link to your website or dropbox (if applicable)
- An exhibition schedule and contract will be emailed after receiving your proposal
- Each artist may exhibit a minimum of one, maximum of 4 works of art at Gallery 625. (The number of artworks per artist TBD and depends upon how many artists will be participating and size of artwork.)

- Digital Images: Submit up to 3 images or media clips of your work. (Images not to exceed 1MB each.)
- About the Artist Statement: No more than 100 characters
