
### *Dear Artists and Supporters,*

This month the Art& Ag Project will revisit an esteemed favorite - The Clarence Scott Ranch. Artists will have the opportunity to catch up with our friend, William A. Chapman, whose great grandparents settled on the property in the 1850s. Our host will share stories and artifacts from his family which has an illustrious history.

In addition, we are pleased to welcome members of the San Francisco Chapter of the California Art Club who will join us on SATURDAY along with Co-Chairs, Ellen Howard and Paul Kratter. Paul will give a painting demo from 9am-11am. (See below for details)

The 4 mile drive into the ranch (off of County Road 89) reveals hidden treasures that are only hints of what lies ahead at the west end of County Road 29. Here nestled at the base of the coastal range by the edge of a ravine stands an old farm house surrounded by enormous oak trees where Clarence and Mary Scott raised their family of four - C. W. "Bill", Emmett, Addeline and Margaret Scott. The initial ranch was developed and settled by Yolo County Pioneer, George Washington and 'Emma' (Bloomer) Scott in the 1850s.

The Clarence Scott Ranch is at the confluence of Pine and Salt Creeks; it is a working cattle ranch with a ranch house that is over a hundred years old. Additional buildings on the property are the barns, saddle house, a cistern and dozens of examples of historical farming equipment including old carts, harrows and a potbellied hog scalding pot. But there's more! As you make your way past the barn you will see a



row of cylindrical corrugated silos against the backdrop of rolling hills and trees. We are excited to be invited back to this historic property and have the opportunity to meet and chat with William A. Chapman, a great grandson of George Washington Scott, who you can read about [HERE](#).
