YoloArts is hosting the fourth annual Yolo County High School Mural Competition. We are looking for high school student groups or class teams to design and fabricate a mural to be installed at the Gibson House and Property in Woodland, CA. This mural will be temporary and will be on view for a period of 1 year.

The 22-23 Mural Competition is funded by a generous donation from the Voss Family Trust.

YoloArts is dedicated to cultivating and enriching people's lives through the arts. This is accomplished through Arts Education Programming, the Barn Gallery, Gallery 625, the Art & Ag program, and Art in Public Places.

Project Criteria:

The artwork selected for the project shall:

- Respond to the theme "Empowered through Struggle". YOUth are invited to consider "How have your personal struggles and challenges empowered you to be better and do better in your community?"
- Have dimensions of 184.5"W x 61.5" H
- Must be a Painted Mural – Supplies will be provided by YoloArts
- Appeal to people of all ages
- Be reflective of the cultural diversity of Yolo County
- Be completed at school site
- Installation will be done by YoloArts

Selection Criteria:

All high school art classes in Yolo County are invited to submit a design proposal. YoloArts' Arts Committee will review all submitted proposals and determine a winner. Artworks will be chosen based on their ability to meet the following criteria:

- Demonstrate creativity, and originality in response to the theme "Empowered through Struggle".
- Ability to meet the project timeline for creation and installation of work.
- Design excellence in past work, including originality of concept, quality of workmanship and materials, as evidence in images of completed projects.

Tentative Schedule:

- January 15, 2023 – Deadline for submission
- January-February, 2023 – Committee Review and Selection
- March 1-15, 2023 – Artist(s) Contracted
- April 24-28, 2023, – Mural Installation
- May, 2023 – Mural Unveiling + Community Celebration

Proposed Location:

This mural will be installed on the side of the Garden Shed, facing the barns, at the Gibson House & Property. See star on diagram.

To be considered, applicants must submit the following via email (subject line "Empowered through Struggle"):

1. An Artist/Class statement – Let the committee know who you are! (PDF)
2. A Narrative description – Tell us about your design! (PDF)
3. Design – Show us how **youth** are emowered in Yolo County! (JPEG – min. 72dpi)
4. Application Form - Basic information about your team (<https://yoloarts.org/call-for-art/>)
5. Portfolio - an example of 1 completed work for each member of your team (*Please combine into 1 PDF*)
6. Letter of Support from Teacher or Faculty Advisor
